 - **Johnny gets up and goes to corner of room;**
 - **Johnny throws an empty (large) water jug at you when you approach him.**

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 3. What kind of responses to Johnny's behavior would **NOT be trauma-informed**?

Positive Behavioral Intervention (PBIS) Lens

1. Looking at his behavior through a Positive Behavioral Intervention lens, why might Johnny have behaved the way he did?
 2. How would we respond to Johnny's behaviors using a Positive Behavioral Intervention approach?
 3. How could you combine your trauma-informed lens with your Positive Behavioral Intervention lens in responding to Johnny?
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
